- Non-indigenous students may be considered if they are pursuing secondary studies in an indigenous program and are members of the ANFC
- graduating grade 12
- consistent academic standing throughout Secondary School
- good % overall average in graduating year
- proceeding on to a Post Secondary institution
- involvement in community/extra curricular activities
- leadership qualities
- good attendance
