



FIX-IT CLUB BURSARY

1. One bursary of \$500 will be available to Grade 12 graduates of Northern Lakes School proceeding on to a post-secondary institution or apprenticeship in a trade or trade-related program.
2. Eligible candidates must apply for this award. The Fix-It Club Board of Directors will determine the successful candidate.
3. The successful candidate will be presented with a certificate of notification at the annual commencement exercises. The actual award will be forwarded to the student once Northern Lakes School has received proof of registration for the second semester from the successful student.
4. The successful candidate shall be a family member of a member of the Atikokan Fix-It Club. If there are no students that fall into this category, it will be open to all students.
5. Should the original bursary recipient decide against continuing his/her education, the bursary may be awarded to another deserving candidate.
