VOLLANS FAMILY TRADES BURSARY

The Vollans Family came to Atikokan in 1953 when Ron & Lil Vollans built the service station on the corner of Mercury Ave and M^{ac}Kenzie Ave under the banner of North Star Oil and in the 1960s, Shell Oil. Their son, Dennis Vollans, pursued a mechanical trade at Steep Rock and Caland, and later worked as an outboard motor technician for Mr. Vic Prokopchuk . Dennis would move to Thunder Bay, where he was employed at Smith’s RV, and in the 1980’s, relocate to BC, where he was involved in the tow truck industry. After starting and selling a small towing company, he owned and operated two additional successful towing companies, which he eventually sold. Mr. Vollans’ involvement in the trades has inspired him to help the young people of Northern Lakes School to achieve success in this valuable area.

1. One bursary of \$500 will be available annually to Grade 12 graduates of Northern Lakes School proceeding on to a post-secondary institution or apprenticeship in a trade or trade related program.
2. Eligible candidates must apply for this award. Northern Lakes School will determine the successful candidate.
3. The successful candidate will be presented with a certificate of notification at the annual commencement exercises. The actual award will be forwarded to the student once Atikokan High School has received proof of registration for the second semester from the successful student.
4. Should the original bursary recipient decide against continuing his/her education, the bursary may be awarded to another deserving candidate.
